Summary

• **Future Continuous:** An action **in progress** at a specific future time.

(e.g., "I will be eating dinner at 8 PM.")

• **Future Perfect:** An action that **will be completed** before a specific future time.

(e.g., "I will have eaten dinner by 8 PM.")

• **Future Perfect Continuous:** An action that **will have been ongoing** for a period of time before a specific future time.

(e.g., "I will have been eating dinner for 30 minutes by 8 PM.")

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Other modal verbs can be used instead of will with Future Continuous and Future Perfect forms to show different degrees of certainty (might, may, could)

يمكن استخدام أفعال أخرى بدلاً من "will" مع الأشكال المستقبلية المستمرة والمستقبلية التامة لإظهار درجات مختلفة من اليقين (might, may, could)

Examples :

- He might be working late tonight. (There is a chance he will be working.)
- She may have completed her project by the end of the month. (It's possible she will have finished it.)
- They could be attending the meeting tomorrow. (It's possible they will attending)

We can use certain phrases with the structure be + adjective + infinitive to talk about how probable it is that a future prediction will actually happen:

- be bound/certain/sure to (this is almost definite) (من المؤكد/المرجح أن هذا شبه مؤكد)
- be likely to (this is probable) (أن هذا محتمل (من المحتمل))
- be unlikely to (this is improbable) (أن هذا غير محتمل (من غير المحتمل))
